New School App

Next week we will be launching our new Seabrook School App. The App will mean that you will be able to access the vast majority of school information in once place and reminders of events and day to day activities will “ping” through to your phone. The App will allow you, with one click to connect to the school website, newsletters and the Innovate website to order school meals.

We will still continue to use Parent Mail for personal texts, forms and online payments but the new app means that information that we currently send by text you will be able to access via the app.

Full instructions will be sent out next week.

New Year Nags and Reminders!

As the new school year starts I would just like to remind you all of the following:

- Doors open at 8.40am for children to go into class.
- Rainbow Fish and Starfish classes are dismissed at 3.10pm and Jellyfish and Swordfish at 3.15pm.
- Please park responsibly when dropping off and collecting children from school. Remember we have a park and stride scheme using the two car parks by the sea front. Parking vouchers can be obtained from the school office.
- Please inform us if someone different is collecting your child and if it is a regular occurrence please let the office know so that it can be recorded.
- Please ensure that your child is wearing the correct school uniform. During this term the children wear the summer uniform of sky blue polo shirts, grey/black trousers or skirts, blue check summer dresses and black shoes (no trainers or boots). In Term 2 the children will wear the winter uniform of white shirts, school tie, black/grey trousers or skirts and navy blue jumper or cardigan.
- PE Kits—on the day your child has PE in school they can come to school in their PE kit rather than their school uniform. Our PE kit is—navy shorts, white t-shirt, plain navy jogging bottoms and school navy hoodie (or jumper/cardigan). Monday—Jellyfish Class; Tuesday—Starfish Class; Wednesday—Rainbow Fish Class and Thursday—Swordfish Class.
- Hair—please can those children that have long hair please tie it up whilst in school and hair accessories are sensible and in line with school uniform policy.
- Jewellery—children should not wear any jewellery to school. Those with pierced ears can wear a small stud earring.

Many of you have ordered dinners for several weeks in advance but if not don't forget that all dinners need to be ordered by 11pm on a Friday for the following week.
