Swordfish class

Small plastic drinks bottles, egg boxes, magazines, cardboard boxes big and small (e.g. cereal, amazon delivery boxes), foil, plastic containers, wrappers from sweets and chocolate bars, newspapers, material and old computer/phone items such as wires, broken phones etc.

Jellyfish class

Empty tin cans, cereal boxes, sweet/chocolate wrappers e.g. quality street, wrapping paper and magazines/comic

Starfish class

2L clear plastic bottles, inside tubes of wrapping paper,
4 pint/2litre milk bottles and plastic bottle lids

Thursday 14th December—Whole school trip to the Panto at The Marlowe Theatre

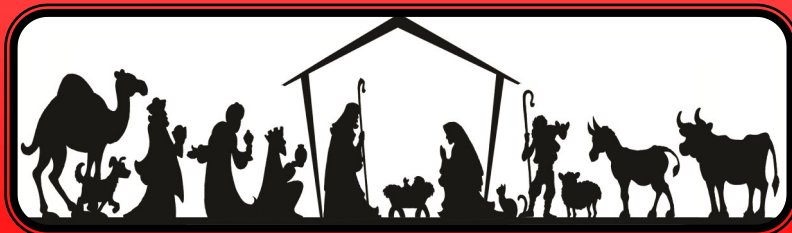
Children will need a packed lunch. Anticipated return time is between 5.15pm and 5.30pm.
