Last week as a school we focused on friendship and the children had the opportunity to wear odd socks and brightly coloured tights to celebrate the fact that we are all unique and different. During worship and PHSE the children had time to explore what makes a good friend. They were very insightful and came up with some very thoughtful comments such as being understanding, kind, respectful and caring, to name but a few. They explored the difference between making occasional wrong choices through unkind comments or actions and discussed how when this persists on a regular basis and is deliberate it can become bullying. The children were then able to discuss how to manage such situations and how the importance of telling a person they trust can help to resolve the situation.
